Summer Term 2021 Pupil Premium

Listening and attention skills continue to be a barrier to learning due to children's absence during lockdown 3 of the Spring Term. This in turn, has impacted on speech and language. A specific articulation group to target speech sounds has been incorporated into the targeted speech and language groups.

The Learning support assistant targets specific fine motor and gross motor skills linked to development of writing for those who leave the nursery to move to reception classes in September and to develop muscle strength for nursery returners.

Continuous provision has been developed to support more child choice and child responsibility of looking after their own resources to support attitude to learning within the classroom and to encourage questioning and thinking skills.

Children's specific needs are identified as per the resource needs chart and resources audited accordingly with additional resources purchased to support learning.

• The impact of this is measured termly through data on pupil premium children in their cohort. Staff look at progress or lack of progress, and annotate next developmental areas / skills that need to be worked on over the next term, to diminish the difference, and support children to make accelerated progress according to their actual age compared to their academic age.

We will be reviewing our school pupil premium strategy at the end of this academic year.

We are supporting the Prime areas of learning with most resource acquisition- the foundations upon all other learning is based upon. Confident children in a safe environment are able to make mistakes and try things and fail, learning from their mistakes and acquiring the strategies to learn new skills to support learning. These skills will help them to diminish the difference in areas of low skill acquisition.
