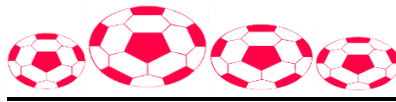

## Summer 2nd half term      Animals Topic - groups 1 & 2

Children preparing to move to Reception in September will continue to focus upon Alliteration of sounds and will be introduced to the second set of phase 2 sounds i, n, m and d.

Younger children will continue to focus on their listening and attention skills and will take part in our Time to Listen sessions and will continue to be introduced to Phase 1 Phonic activities.

In mathematics, all children will revisit the Ten Town characters alongside their weekly maths focus. They will also continue to subitise using visual pictures and games.
